## Program Overview:

The *Chief Minister Honhaar Merit Scholarship Program* is launched by the Government of Punjab to financially assist high-achieving students enrolled in public sector universities. The program aims to promote academic excellence by covering tuition fees and supporting bright students in their undergraduate studies.

### Eligibility Criteria:

- Must be a Punjab domicile holder.
- Enrolled in a full-time undergraduate degree program (morning session only) at a public sector university in Punjab.
- Secured at least 70% marks in Intermediate or equivalent.
- Must not be receiving any other scholarship (need-based or merit-based).

#### Scholarship Benefits:

- Full or partial tuition fee coverage (as per actual).
- Renewable annually based on satisfactory academic performance.

#### Required Documents:

Students must upload clear scanned copies of the following documents:

- 1. Student CNIC or Form-B
- 2. Father's/Guardian's CNIC
- 3. Intermediate Result Card
- 4. Admission Letter or Bonafide Certificate from University
- 5. Punjab Domicile Certificate

#### 6. Undertaking of non-receipt of any other scholarship

# 17 Application Process:

- Eligible students can apply online through the PHEC scholarship portal.
- Incomplete or incorrect applications will not be considered.
- The university will verify and forward eligible applications to the relevant authorities.
