PEEF Undergraduate Scholarship Program – 2025

Program Overview:

The *Punjab Educational Endowment Fund (PEEF)* offers scholarships to talented and deserving students enrolled in undergraduate programs at public sector universities of Punjab. The initiative aims to promote equitable access to higher education for students from low-income families and underprivileged backgrounds.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Must have passed Intermediate (FA/F.Sc/ICS/DAE/I.Com) examination from a government institution.
- Must have secured at least 60% marks in Intermediate.
- Must be enrolled in a regular full-time undergraduate degree program in a public sector university/college.
- Monthly family income must not exceed Rs. 60,000.
- Must hold a Punjab domicile.
- Must not be receiving any other scholarship for this program.

Special Quota Categories (If Applicable):

- Orphans (lost both parents)
- Children of government employees (Grade 1–4)
- Minority students
- Students with special needs/disabilities
- Students belonging to Balochistan, FATA, Gilgit-Baltistan, AJK, or Islamabad Capital Territory (for inter-provincial quota)

Scholarship Benefits:

Full tuition fee reimbursement

Monthly stipend to cover living expenses (as per PEEF policy)



Required Documents:

- 1. Copy of Matric and Intermediate result cards
- 2. Copy of CNIC/Form-B
- 3. Father's/Guardian's CNIC
- 4. Income certificate (issued by Tehsildar/Head of Institution/Employer)
- 5. Domicile certificate (Punjab)
- 6. Bonafide letter from the university
- 7. Death certificate (if applying under orphan category)
- 8. Disability certificate (if applicable)
- 9. Minority certificate (if applicable)

- Application forms can be downloaded from the PEEF website or obtained from the Directorate of Financial Assistance.
- Submit filled form with supporting documents to the university's financial aid office.
- University forwards eligible applications to PEEF for final selection.

PEEF Master's Level Scholarship Program – 2025

**Program Overview:

The Punjab Educational Endowment Fund (PEEF)** awards fully funded scholarships to talented and deserving students enrolled in Master's (MA/MSc/MS/MPhil equivalent) degree programs at public sector universities of Punjab. The program is designed to support students from low-income families so they can pursue higher education without financial barriers.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Must have passed BA/BSc/BS/B.Com or equivalent (14/16 years of education) from a government institution.
- Secured at least 60% marks or minimum CGPA of 2.5 out of 4.0 in the last degree.
- Must be enrolled in a full-time Master's level program (morning/evening) in a public sector university/college.
- Monthly family income should not exceed Rs. 60,000.
- Must hold a Punjab domicile.
- Must not be receiving any other scholarship for the same degree program.

Special Quota Categories (if applicable):

- Orphan students (both parents deceased)
- Children of government employees (Grade 1–4)
- Minority students
- Students with special needs
- Children residing in less-developed districts of Punjab

Scholarship Benefits:

• Tuition fee coverage (as per actual university fee)

Monthly stipend (as per PEEF policy)



Required Documents:

- 1. Attested copies of BA/BSc/BS result card
- 2. CNIC/Form-B of student
- 3. CNIC of father/guardian
- 4. Punjab Domicile Certificate
- 5. Bonafide Certificate from university
- 6. Income certificate of father/guardian
- 7. Relevant documents for special quota category (if applicable)



17 Application Process:

- Application forms can be obtained from the Directorate of Financial Assistance or downloaded from PEEF website.
- Submit the duly filled application form along with all required documents to the university's financial aid office.
- University shortlists and forwards eligible applications to PEEF for final approval and disbursement.
